Affordable Home Care Services

is a registry of home care workers, serving seniors and adults with disabilities in Alameda County who need assistance in the home. Workers are screened by BACS and hired directly by the individuals or family members, either privately or through the IHSS system. This program enables consumers with physical and/or mental impairments to live in their homes and prevents or delays institutionalization.

Care Management

helps elders in Alameda County remain in their homes by providing in-home assessment, arrangement of needed services, ongoing monitoring and referrals to resources. This program is available for low and moderate income elders who don't qualify for other care management services. It assists those who, due to lack of family or other support, are unable to access necessary health and social services. Priority is given to individuals at risk of abuse.

Meals on Wheels and Senior Nutrition Services

provides hot, nutritious meals to seniors 60 or older who reside in Oakland, Alameda and Piedmont. Meals are delivered to congregate dining sites and to the home bound frail elderly who are unable to cook or shop for themselves. These meals are delivered by caring drivers who are often the only social contact the senior has on a daily basis. Meals meet 1/3 of the recommended dietary allowances, helping seniors to stay healthy and independent.

Money Management Assistance Program

serves frail, low-income seniors throughout Alameda County in order to protect them from financial abuse and exploitation. The program utilizes trained and supervised volunteers. Volunteers serve as Bill Payers or Representative Payees. They may assist with writing checks, reconciling financial statements, budgeting and record keeping.

Senior Transportation

provides reliable transportation on weekdays for seniors living in residential facilities or living in neighboring apartments and homes. There is no charge for this fixed route service that provides access to grocery shopping, senior centers, and other destinations for health and business needs. For the passengers' convenience, an attendant assists with boarding and packaging.
